

Greasley Parish Council Walks

Preamble : A series of Monday evening walks in and around the parish. Walks start at 6.45pm and vary from 2¾ to 6 miles. The walks will be mainly off road, stiles and farm animals may be encountered. Paths may be wet or muddy so suitable footwear is essential.

Routes may vary from described depending on ground conditions.

Greasley Footpath Walk Number 1

From Greasley Church we walk field paths at the rear of the Church, through Watnall Wood onto Cliff Boulevard (steep climb) and Alma Hill before returning via field paths to the church

Date: 2nd May Time: 6.45pm

Distance: 4 miles Duration: 2 hours.

Meet: Greasley Church (park in lay-by in front of the church on the B600 between Moorgreen and Watnall)

Grid ref SK490 472 Post Code NG16 2AB

Greasley Footpath Walk Number 2

From Kimberley we walk through the Great Northern railway cutting then continue along the line through Watnall. Then by Bulwell Wood and field paths to Long Lane, returning via Watnall to Kimberley

Date: 23rd May Time: 6.45pm

Distance: 4½ miles Duration: 2½ hours

Meet: in front of the Nelson and Railway Public House on Station Street

Greasley Footpath Walk Number 3

From Greasley Church we walk to Bogend to walk field paths to Narrow Lane and the site of Watnall brickworks, then up Misk Hill (steep climb). Returning via Misk Farm, Narrow Road and Brooksbreasting Farm

Distance: 6 miles Duration: 3 hours

Meet: Greasley Church (park in lay-by in front of the church, on the B600 between Moorgreen and Watnall)

Grid: ref SK490 472 Post Code NG16 2AB

Greasley Footpath Walk Number 4

This evening Ann Whyte of Beauvale Priory will join us as joint leader on a walk through Moorgreen Woods then Kennel Lane and Weavers lane, returning via Felley Mill and the woods.

Date: 27th June Time: 6.45pm

Distance: 5½ miles Duration: 3 hours

Meet: Beauvale Priory, New Road, Moorgreen

Greasley Footpath Walk Number 5

From Awsworth we walk a former railway track before crossing the Awsworth by-pass to follow the Nottingham Canal and paths to Bennerley Viaduct then onto footpaths and lanes in the Erewash valley. Returning via Newthorpe and Awsworth

Date: 11th July Time: 6.45pm

Distance: 5½ miles Duration: 2¾ hours

Meet: The Gate Inn, Awsworth Lane, Awsworth (small car park at side of pub or road side parking)

Grid ref SK 485 445 Post Code NG16 2RN

Greasley Footpath Walk Number 6

From Giltbrook we walk paths down to the A610 by-pass to emerge by the Trading Estate. We cross two roads to walk up Gilthill then take a path to Alma Hill. Down then via Reckoning House farm, Watnall Wood, and the Gilt Brook to Baker Road and back to the Hayloft.

Date: 25th July Time: 6.45pm

Distance: 4¼ miles Duration: 2½ miles

Meet: The Hayloft Public House (car park at the rear), Nottingham Road, Giltbrook

Grid Ref SK 482 458 Post Code NG16 2GB

Greasley Footpath Walk Number 7

From Hall Lane, Brinsley we cross the main road to walk to Brinsley Headstocks then footpaths and farm lane to Coneygre and Willey Wood farms. Then field paths back to the main road to cross and take paths to Winter Closes and Broad Lane. Returning to the start via The Moor

Date: 8th August Time: 6.45pm

Distance: 4 miles Duration: 2 hours

Meet: The White Lion Public House, Hall Lane (small car park at rear or at the road side)

Grid Ref SK 459 488 Post Code NG16 5AH

Greasley Footpath Walk Number 8

From Watnall we cross Watnall Green on to "the cliff" (steep climb) then through Watnall Wood and Wood Pit cottages to the B600. We cross the road onto the old Church Lane then down to the Bogend path up to Narrow Lane to return via field paths to Watnall

Date: 22nd August Time: 6 45pm

Distance 2¾ miles Duration 1¾ hours

Meet: The Royal Oak public House, Main Road, Watnall (car park on opposite side of road or park at road side)
