10	<u>To approve the minutes of the meeting 24th September 2018</u> The minutes of the meeting held on 24th September 2018 had been previously circulated and were agreed and signed by the Chairman.	
11	<u>To discuss Parish Council events</u> a) <u>WW1 Commemoration</u> - The Clerk confirmed that the silhouette soldier had been ordered and it would be delivered in time for the 11 th November 2018. She went on to advise that she had met with Reverend Marvin and he was already putting an order of service together for Remembrance Sunday and had confirmed that the church would arrange refreshments in the church hall after the service. The Chairman advised that the exhibition of artwork by local schools will be going ahead on 26 th October 2018 at the Sports and Community Centre and plans are well under way for the community concert on 10 th November 2018. He also stated that help would be needed to put poppies up on lamp posts in the area once these arrive. b) <u>Christmas event</u> – Cllr Barry advised that she had asked the Centre staff to design a new poster for this year’s event and she is currently working her way through a list of things to do including organising the Christmas tree, contacting local businesses for support and liaising with Greasley Beauvale Primary School about entertainment. Cllr Limb confirmed that he had spoken with Rofotec the Council’s electrical contractors about the fixed wiring condition report for the external lights and this would be carried out as soon as possible. Cllr Barry confirmed that she would then liaise with the Centre manager about getting the Christmas lights checked and put back up in the trees.	All MB AL MB
